





they turned somewhere else for safety.


e.g. When facing the Assyrian Empire they turned to Egypt for help. Isaiah 31:1


God wants to help but His people turn to the world instead of Him.

The New Testament reaffirms this -









This command is followed by giving the genealogy of Noah and his sons.

"I personally hold to the understanding that the "Sons of God," which is the term "Bene Elohim," are, in fact, angels, and those angels came down and commingled with the "Daughters of Men." We find in Verse 4 that this union happened, and they had children together.

As crazy as that sounds, please understand there is a reason God destroyed all flesh on the planet with the flood except Noah and his family. But I will come back to that. The thing I want you to know is that the term used in Genesis 6, "Sons of God" or "Bane Elohim," while not used often, when it is used elsewhere in the book of Job it is speaking of angels, not men, not humans, but angels, and direct creations of God."

Jude 5-7

Jude quotes the book of Enoch. Enoch is not a part of the canon of scripture primarily because "The Book of Enoch is any of several <u>pseudepigraphal</u> works that


attribute themselves to Enoch, the great-grandfather of Noah; that is, Enoch son of Jared (<u>Genesis 5:18</u>). A piece of ancient literature is a pseudepigraphon if it makes false claims as to authorship. A pseudepigraphon will purport to have a (usually) well-known author, but its claims are unfounded.

The biblical book of Jude quotes from chapter 1 of the Book of Enoch in Jude <u>1:14–15</u>, "Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men: 'See, the Lord is coming with thousands upon thousands of his holy ones to judge everyone, and to convict all the ungodly of all the ungodly acts they have done in the ungodly way, and of all the harsh words ungodly sinners have spoken against him.'" Jude's quotation does not mean the Book of Enoch is inspired by God or that it should be in the Bible.

Jude's quote is not the only quote in the Bible from a non-biblical source. The apostle Paul quotes Epimenides in <u>Titus 1:12</u>, but that does not mean we should give any additional authority to Epimenides' writings. The same is true with <u>Jude 1:14–15</u>. Jude quoting from the Book of Enoch does not indicate the entire Book of Enoch is inspired, or even true. All it means is that particular passage of Enoch is true. It is interesting to note that no scholars believe the Book of Enoch to have truly been written by the Enoch in the Bible. Enoch was seven generations from Adam, prior to the flood (<u>Genesis 5:1–24</u>). Evidently, though, the words Jude quotes were genuinely something that Enoch prophesied—or the Bible would not attribute it to him: "Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men" (Jude 1:14). This saying of Enoch was somehow handed down through the generations and eventually recorded in the Book of Enoch.

We should treat the Book of Enoch (and the other books like it) in the same manner we do the other apocryphal writings. Some of what the <u>Apocrypha</u> says is true and correct, but much of it is false and historically inaccurate. If you read these books, you should consider them interesting but fallible historical documents, not as the inspired, authoritative Word of God.

"Why are you spending time on this Nimrod?" You ask. "Because it is so very important to understand who the first ruler of the original "Harlot" was. The "Mother of Harlots," a city called Babel in the land that would become Babylon. Because I believe it's on this foundation the last "Harlot" will be built. We read in Verse 10, just after describing who Nimrod was, it tells us of the beginning of his kingdom. It reads, "And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar."


The modern-day location of Shinar is Iraq, with some of it extending to Kuwait and small parts of Iran. This is where the infamous "Tower of Babel" was built, in the city of Babel in modern-day Iraq. If you know anything about that area, it is desert. It is not surrounded by "many waters," as previously noted. But, again, we will come back to that.

The Act of Rebellion

Nimrod, who was a rebel, a tyrant, and a wicked man, we learn in Genesis 11, began to openly rebel against God. But, remember, his family was cursed by Noah to be the servant of servants to his brethren. So, I am sure that story had been passed down among the generations. However, Nimrod, as a foreshadowing of the Antichrist, would obviously not be a servant. Instead, he would seek to rule over not only his brethren but all of mankind, which would have been various degrees of cousins, aunts, uncles, etc. Because remember, the earth was to be repopulated with the offspring of Noah's three sons and their wives. And so we see Genesis 11 starts with describing this place, Babel. We know from Genesis

10 that Nimrod was the King of Babel and all of Shinar.




